2017-18 Action Plan

Action Item #1: Promote Quality Educational Programming

Action Steps:

- Enhance the Grade 3-6 STEM program through creative, challenging grade-level appropriate curriculum and providing opportunities for all students to learn about pathways leading to STEM careers
- Engage all students with curriculum based on the New York State Learning Standards including updates around the New York State K-12 Science and Social Studies Frameworks
- Support research-based best instructional strategies in Reading, Writing, and Math including the implementation of workshop models in reading and writing
- Implement and support researched-based recommendations around physical fitness and nutrition through creative scheduling of physical education classes, wellness, and recess

Action Item #2: Promote a Safe and Supportive Learning Environment

Action Steps:

- Encourage, promote, and support a Leadership Culture through teaching and implementing *The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People* and the *Six Pillars of Character*
- Promote a Leadership Culture through encouraging and supporting the purposeful recognition of students and staff for modeling Leadership and Character Virtues
- Promote a Leadership Culture by supporting student-led activities, monthly assemblies, student fundraising projects, and Community Service and Outreach-based Projects
- Promote an Emotionally-safe school environment through thoughtful implementation and practice of school-wide emergency drills per our School Building Safety Plan

Action Item #3: Know, Challenge, and Support Every Student

Action Steps:

- Utilize multiple measures of reliable student achievement data to drive core instruction, identify individual student performance targets, and create challenging school-wide goals
- Administer common grade-level ELA and Math Benchmarks and end-of-year Summative Assessments and analyze results to identify areas of growth and student need
- Communicate with parents and families around daily classroom expectations, student progress in core areas and attendance, and school-wide educational events
- Engage all students through opportunities to be involved in School-based Extra-curricular clubs and to determine areas of student interest for future clubs and activities
